COVID-19 Safety Practices

Welcome to Bumblebunch Sewing Studio!

During this time of COVID-19, we all understand that staying flexible and keeping informed are incredibly helpful. We can welcome students for in-person classes when the State of California AND the County of San Bernardino say that it is safe to do so. Please visit the County of San Bernardino's COVID-19 website at <http://sbccovid19.com/> and the State of California website at <https://covid19.ca.gov/> for updates and details.

Bumblebunch Sewing Studio will comply with the safety guidelines issued for our business category. These practices will include:

- Parents agree to check their child's temperature and not bring the student to class with a temperature above what is normal for the student. A refund will be issued for the missing class time.
- Parents agree that if the student has been in close contact with a person with COVID-19 to not attend class. A refund will be issued for the missing class time.
- The student's temperature will be taken upon entering the studio.
- We will keep the teacher student ratio at 1:4. With only 5 people max in the studio space of 800 square feet.
- 6' distance between all individuals during class time.
- Individual workstations have been created for each student and all of the supplies and surfaces at the workstations will be disinfected after every class. Any shared tools will be disinfected before handing it to the student.
- Each work station is approximately 10 feet away from each other
- Wearing of a face covering by all students and teachers is required
- Staggered and frequent hand washing with soap will be required for students and teachers.
- For additional safety, parents are to drop off and pick up their student in the hallway and not enter the studio.
